Scholarship Award Criteria

Each year, the Multnomah Chapter of Master Gardeners offers three scholarships to its member Master Gardeners to attend the annual OSU Extension Service Mini-College.

The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage attendance and participation in this statewide event and to enhance your experiences as a Master Gardener. Selections will be based on the criteria below and are not dependent on financial need.

Scholarship applications are due May 15, 2012. Winners will be notified by June 1, 2012.

Candidate must have been a Master Gardener for at least one year.

Candidate must have completed annual MG volunteer requirement.

Candidate must be a current member of Multnomah Chapter.

Candidate must be attending Mini College for the first time.

Candidate shall respond in the following area:

(40%) What volunteer Master Gardener activities have you participated in during the past year(s)? The candidate should show that he/she is fulfilling the mission of the Master Gardener Program.

(40%) Describe your participation in Multnomah Chapter activities. The candidate should show that he/she is supporting the activities and mission of the Chapter

(15%) What do you expect to get out of Mini College? The candidate is expected to understand the purpose of Mini College and to have considered how he/she could benefit from it.

(5%) Number of years as an OSU Master Gardener.

If more than three people apply, winners will be determined by the number of volunteer hours candidate has contributed to the Program.
