1. To access the Home Use information, locate the **Chapter** box at top left
2. In the **Chapter** box, click the down arrow following the word *Introduction*
3. Scroll down to locate the sections for Home Use
 - a. *Home Garden*
 - b. *Home Landscape and Lawn*
 - c. *Nuisance, Public Health, Log, Structural*
4. A new page opens when you click on the desired section (e.g. *Home Garden*)
 - a. The box at the top left is **Chapter: Home Garden**
 - b. The box at the top right is
Section: Home Garden – Insecticides for Home Garden and Orchard Pests
(This chart lists characteristics of active ingredients)
5. Go to the **Section** box; click the down arrow to see additional Home Use topics

2. Scroll to the listing for *Pea*, and click
3. On the new page, look for *Pea*
 - a. Find the info about *Armyworm and Cutworm*
